The above chart represents how our 2017 disbursements and commitments will be allocated across areas of care throughout Cape Breton. In total, \$3,936,955 is being invested into the health of Cape Bretoners – *thank you!*

For 2017, our total fundraising expenses represent 15.4% of total fundraising revenue. This is 56% lower than the industry fundraising expense ratio standard of 35% according to Canada Revenue Agency.

Courage Comes From Superheroes

More than \$290,000 raised by Caleb's Courage in 2017

On May 17th, 2017, the official Caleb's Courage flag was raised at the Cape Breton Regional Hospital to honour Cape Breton's favourite little superhero, Caleb MacArthur, and to let the world know that Caleb's Superhero Suite, in the Pediatrics Unit, is ready to comfort sick kids and their families.

After losing their son to Neuroblastoma, Caleb's parents Mike and Nicole have continued his legacy of fighting hard and never giving up. With their experience, they felt they had the tools and ideas to make a real difference.

The MacArthurs started a fundraising movement in June 2015, in the hopes of building a room to honour Caleb and to support families of critically ill children in their own journeys through palliative care. After many fundraising events, relentless work, the generosity of a remarkable community, and the support of the AVIVA Community Fund, the MacArthur family has raised over \$200,000 to build this room.

After months of hard work and dedication from three local community businesses, who volunteered their services; Brilun Construction, Dora Construction and Joneljim Concrete Construction, as well as many subcontractors and other generous contributors,

the room was ready in May of 2017. Over \$120,000 in services and supplies were donated to this project since its inception.

The MacArthur family is now focused on continuing Caleb's legacy through an endowment fund that will support the Pediatrics Unit at the Cape Breton Regional Hospital, specifically, Pediatric Oncology/Palliative Care. It will be used to enhance supports and overall quality of life for critically ill children and their families by funding specialized equipment, programs, and services during their time in hospital and at home, as well as following the loss of a child.

Swinging to Help Little Superheroes Fighting BIG Battles

Cape Breton's NuStar Energy steps up to Support Cancer Care and Caleb's Courage Story

Golf tournaments are always a fun way to raise funds, but rarely do they make this kind of a local impact. This summer, the NuStar Energy Fairways to Success Golf Tournament raised \$115,000 to support Caleb's Courage Legacy Fund and the Cape Breton Regional Hospital Foundation's Cancer Patient Care Fund.

NuStar embraced Caleb's superhero movement with enthusiasm and passion. In addition to the golf tournament, NuStar gave an additional \$5,000 to round it up to \$120,000.

The Cancer Patient Care Fund provides financial assistance to cancer patients at the Cape Breton Cancer Centre during treatment. The fund would not exist without the support of a generous community and businesses like NuStar Energy. In 2017 alone, \$336,000 was disbursed to cancer patients in Cape Breton through this fund.

Caleb's Courage Legacy Fund was created with love by Caleb's parents as a way to honour their son, and, with the help of the Cape Breton Regional Hospital Foundation, to make a positive impact in healthcare for families all over Cape Breton Island.

Thanks to Nustar Energy, the endowment fund will be able to support little superheroes fighting big battles and cancer patients facing financial struggles. It's businesses like this that

remind us that we live in the most caring community in the world.

The gift has since enhanced both the hospital and university, with an emergency room renovation as well as the building of the Harriss Hall at CBU.



Reeling in big support & saving lives

Fishing for heart health

Jeff almost died last year. The Executioner was the name of the boat he was working on. It’s a fitting name for the boat that nearly took his life. After diving beneath to repair the vessel, Jeff suffered a major heart attack.

6 years ago, when Jeff helped start the Mako My Day Shark Derby, he knew he wanted to give back to the Cape Breton Regional Hospital. He knew that everyone in his life had used the hospital or knows someone who has. He had no idea that it would be him in urgent need of the Hospital’s services.

The Shark Derby has raised more than \$42,000 for the hospital so far. This year the money went to Operation Heart to ensure world-class care is offered here - at home. Not only did the derby fully fund Pace-Art software, equipment which tracks progress of over 1,500 patients in Cape Breton a year, and monitors them at home, it also helped fund a new Operating Room table.

Without the important equipment and services available, Jeff wouldn’t be here today. He wouldn’t fish another day, he wouldn’t host another shark derby and he wouldn’t see his children grow up. He’s here today because his community gives back. Jeff’s heart is healthy today and Cape Breton’s generosity has lead him to living an even more positive life.

A record breaking year!

In a new partnership with 101.9 The Giant and New Country 103.5, Cape Breton broke records this year, raising a staggering \$1,016,697 for the Cape Breton Regional Hospital, an increase of 44% over last year's total. Thanks to many important donors: MECO Construction DKI, Jim Sampson Motors, Father Albert Maroun, OTS, the fishermen of Cape Breton led by long time donors Joe Anthony and Jimmy Kennedy, all who called to make a pledge and too many more to name, we were able to purchase vital equipment for our operating room and cardiac care.



Kids stepping up to make some real change

Our youngest donors remind us that kindness comes from the heart

2017 was a year of generosity. Many gifts were made to strengthen healthcare in Cape Breton and the gifts from our youngest donors truly warm the heart. Every child who made a gift this year, makes us proud of our community, but some kids really stood out.

Ten year old Sam Gracie raised over \$3,600 to support the purchase of EEG equipment and operating room equipment in Cape Breton. Not only did his team, Hattie Heroes, win the Because You Care Cup by raising the most money in the 2017 road hockey tournament, but he was also the top fundraiser for the entire tournament. After such a successful summer of fundraising, he jumped at the opportunity to become a Sydney Credit Union Changemaker.

The Sydney Credit Union Changemakers, who were almost exclusively children, raised an incredible \$12,537 for Operation Heart. Another set of Changemakers were Julia and Jansen Chiasson. This sibling duo fundraised at their school and in the community and raised a lot of money in their community. As a way of showing the importance of community, they chronicled their journey in a Changemaker booklet.

Another group who warmed many hearts was the The CBU Early Childhood Centre. The children heard about the Changemakers campaign and formed the most adorable committee of fundraisers we may have ever seen. This group of three and four year olds sold baked goods, held events and raised an incredible \$2,000 so, "The doctors can make people who are sick feel better again."

Finally, our little Niel Planetta, the youngest fundraiser this year, raised money for the Operation Heart campaign with the help of his family and friends. This was especially important to Niel and his family because he was born with a cardiac condition and his mom credits the Cape Breton Regional Hospital with saving his life.

We often focus on teaching kids, informing them about the right thing to do and how to do it. This year, kids taught us about how precious our healthcare is and how kindness goes a long way to making Cape Breton a healthier place to live.
