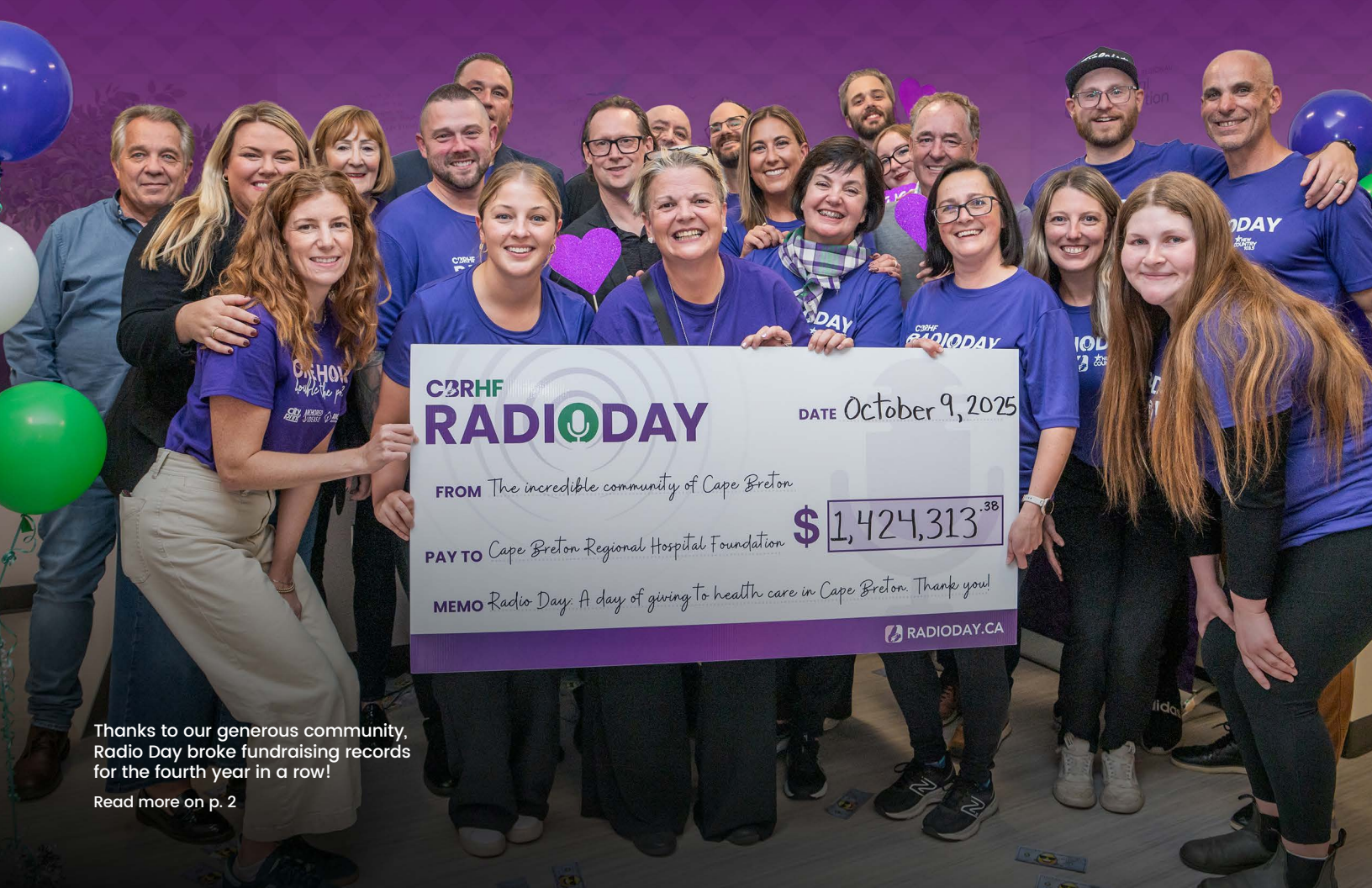

A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR

This past year has been one of incredible momentum and impact. As I reflect on my final year as Chair of the Board, I am filled with the utmost gratitude for our small yet mighty community.

I am proud to share that - because of our donors, partners, volunteers, and supporters - 2025 was another record-breaking fundraising year for the Foundation. Working together, we raised more than **\$4.8 million** in support of health care here at home.

Radio Day broke records for the fourth year in a row, raising **\$1.4 million** and bringing new technology to the Island. **Festival of the Greens** saw a tremendous **\$220,478.00** raised. **Golf Because You Care** and our **community fundraisers** also set records, raising **\$55,529.86** and **\$1.1 million** respectfully.

As fundraising continues to grow, so too does our impact. In 2025, more than **\$2.3 million** was disbursed to priority health care initiatives – **\$300,000.00 more than in the previous year** - helping to meet the

increasing needs in Cape Breton. Together, we're investing in life-saving equipment, innovative research, direct patient support, and more.

Serving on this Board has been an honour. I want to sincerely thank my fellow Board members for their leadership and commitment, the Foundation staff for their passion and hard work, and our donors and supporters for their trust, dedication and generosity. It has truly been a privilege to be part of something so meaningful.

A MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

I am left in awe as I look back at 2025: a year of meaningful growth and deepened impact for our Foundation. Thanks to the continued generosity of our community, we have expanded both our reach and our ability to support health care workers, patients, and families when they need it most.

We are honoured to be supported by **5,386 donors** in 2025 - an increase over last year - whose collective commitment resulted in **16,667 gifts**. Each contribution, regardless of size, reflects a shared belief in strengthening health care close to home. This growing momentum is a powerful reminder of what can be achieved when a community comes together with shared purpose.

Most importantly, these contributions translated directly into care. This year, **5,227 patients** were supported through Foundation-funded programs and initiatives, nearly doubling the number from the previous year. Additionally, thanks to donor generosity, we were able to fund **22 pieces of equipment** to support the work of our Island's health care experts.

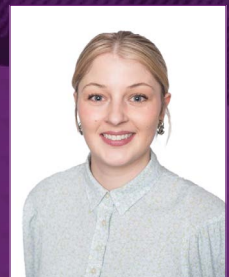

RADIODAY 4-year streak

October 9, 2025: The day that Radio Day broke all previous fundraising records, for the *fourth year in a row*.

The day was filled with heart, energy, and community-driven impact, as the 18th annual radiothon raised an incredible **\$1,424,313.38** for health care in Cape Breton. This milestone brings the event's historical total to over **\$14 million**.

A portion of funds raised has been dedicated to purchasing two lifesaving Prismax machines for the Intensive Care Unit at the Cape Breton Regional Hospital (CBRH). These machines, which will be the first of their kind to arrive in Cape Breton, will

improve critically sick people's chances of survival (read more on the next page).

This record-breaking success would not be possible without our amazing community. We extend a heartfelt thank you to **Hot 101.9** and **New Country 103.5** for their outstanding partnership; our Power Hour Partners **City Print+**, **Schwartz Furniture**, and **Jim Sampson Motors**; our Online Matching Partner, **C.S. Boudreau Holdings Ltd.**; those who shared their health care stories; our outstanding **volunteers**; dozens of **community fundraisers** and more than **3,200 individual donors**.

NEW

lifesaving technology coming to Cape Breton

Soon, for the first time ever, critically ill patients at the CBRH will have access to a new and advanced lifesaving technology.

Thanks to the generosity of donors to Radio Day 2025, two 'Prismax' machines have been ordered for the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). These machines, while on their way, are currently only available off-Island.

"When kidneys fail, which is unfortunately a common and life-threatening complication we see in patients in the ICU, the body can no longer remove dangerous waste and fluid on its own," shares Dr. Kevin Klassen, Physician Lead, ICU.

"This can happen with patients experiencing sepsis, severe trauma, major heart attacks, or blood loss. Without kidneys, a person cannot survive."

In these situations, the Prismax gives patients a better chance of survival.

The machines mimic the natural function of healthy kidneys by gently filtering blood 24 hours a day, which is different from traditional dialysis which works rapidly over just four hours. This allows patients to be a lot more stable, rather than putting immense stress and strain on an already fragile body.

Bringing these machines to our hospital ensures our Island's health care experts have the tools they need to give our friends, families, and neighbours the best possible care, right here at home.

"My colleagues and I thank you for your continued commitment to health care in Cape Breton," says Dr. Klassen.

Thank you to everyone who played a role in bringing this lifesaving technology to our Island!

The 21st annual **Festival of the Greens, presented by Cape Breton Beverages, Nova Scotia Spirit Co. - Blue Lobster and Annapolis Cider Company**, sold-out with more than 450 guests gathering at the Membertou Trade & Convention Centre in late November.

The fundraising portion of the evening included an online silent auction, followed by a live, in-person auction led by New Country 103.5's Tashia Lee.

The event also recognized the late Alfie MacLeod, a long-time supporter of Festival of the Greens and the voice of charitable live auctions in Cape Breton. In his memory, "A Toast to Alfie," was offered as the signature cocktail, with all proceeds supporting the night's fundraising efforts thanks to our sponsor, Membertou Trade and Convention Centre.

The Gala's fundraising total was unveiled at the end of the evening, announcing an incredible **\$220,478.00** for health care in Cape Breton. This brings Festival of the Greens' historical impact to more than **\$2.9 million**.

DONOR IMPACT

\$2.3 MILLION disbursed to priority health care needs

As a donor to our Foundation, your impact is vast. It is seen every day, throughout every floor of the Cape Breton Regional Hospital and beyond. Here are some examples of how your generosity has helped to strengthen health care, here in Cape Breton, in 2025.

RENOVATIONS

\$32,852.00

Several spaces within the hospital were renovated in 2025, including the **Neonatal Intensive Care Unit's (NICU) Family Room**, pictured here. The room has been transformed from a clinical space to a welcoming one where families can comfortably stay long-term alongside their sick babies.



PATIENT CARE

\$1,266,964.00

Because of our donors, **5,227 Cape Bretoners** received support to travel to specialist appointments, afford medications not covered by insurance, access psychosocial support programming, purchase personal accessibility equipment, and more. **This number has nearly doubled since 2024**, showcasing the growing need in our community.

EQUIPMENT

\$972,253.00

Our Foundation saw one of the largest years of disbursements for equipment in 2025, with **22 pieces purchased**. This included supporting **Pathways Cape Breton** to purchase a new vehicle, allowing those living with **mental health** challenges to get safely to job sites as part of their support programming. LEAVING A *legacy*

Giving from the Ground Up

The **Cape Breton Building Trades and Unionized Contractors** have now completed their incredible pledge of **\$500,000.00** to our **Cancer Care Here at Home Campaign**.

This half-a-million-dollar donation is the largest gift ever given to any organization by the group and is a result of payroll deductions received from unionized employees and matched by contractors.

Beyond this outstanding financial contribution, group members are also those responsible for building the new state-of-the-art centre, truly leaving their mark on our Island and our community.

"The significance of this gift matches our desire to build and have access to health care services, like the new Cancer Centre, here at home," says Ernie Dalton, President of the Cape Breton Building Trades Council. "We are proud to be building this Cancer Centre in partnership with the unionized contractors, and we feel fortunate to be able to give back by means of donation as well."

The Cancer Care Here at Home campaign - the largest in the Foundation's history - raised **\$15,054,053.00** to support Cape Breton's new Cancer Centre, which is currently under construction and expected to open in 2027.

Funds raised during the campaign are already being disbursed to purchase **14 new pieces of equipment**; launch a new **research and innovation fund** to expand the current research being done at the Cape Breton Cancer Centre; and sustain and expand **direct patient support programming** which currently supports up to 100 patients each month.

"This is a transformational gift for cancer care in Cape Breton, for which we are incredibly grateful," says Mike McPhee, Chair, Cancer Care Here at Home Campaign. "What the building trades and the unionized contractors have done truly showcases the spirit of Cape Breton - working together for the greater good of our community."

COMMUNITY THAT *cares*

In 2025, there were **64 community-led** fundraisers hosted across the Island in support of our Foundation. Through these initiatives, **\$1,103,456.96** was raised – the most ever raised collectively by community fundraisers in our history!

Additionally, our Foundation secured **\$194,500.00** in community grants this year. Thank you to the dedicated changemakers in our community who continue to give their time and energy to uplift our friends, families, and neighbours, when they need it most.



The **5th Annual Washer Toss Tournament in loving memory of Bill Steele** raised **\$1,600.00 for the Cardiac Unit**. The group – which includes Sheri Fortune, our Foundation’s Database Manager and wife to Bill – hosts the tournament to remember and honour their loved one, while giving back in his memory. To date, Bill’s family and friends have raised \$13,770.00 for cardiac care in Cape Breton.

Ria Kelloway, a local fourth grader, sold homemade jewelry to raise **\$1,750.00 in loving memory of her ‘Bampie,’** who was impacted by lung disease. Her gift supports **‘All for Lungs & Lungs for All’** and those needing to travel out of province to receive transplants. To date, Ria has raised \$2,785.00 for this cause, along with donating care packages to pediatric patients.



Harbour Wars, which takes place in Little Harbour L’Ardoise, saw a record-breaking year with **\$75,000.00 raised for the Tom McNeil Cancer Patient Care Fund**. This annual event celebrates the fishing industry of Richmond County, featuring fisher skills competitions where teams of four battle to be the top crew. This amazing initiative has now raised more than \$258,330.39 to provide financial relief to those battling cancer.

Thanks to the **Mental Health Foundation of Nova Scotia**, we received a grant of **\$25,000.00 for the Mental Health & Addictions Patient Care Fund**. Their generosity allowed **600** local mental health and addictions patients to purchase prescriptions not covered by insurance, access emergency dental care, travel to health care appointments, and more. We are grateful to have received a total of \$117,500.00 from MHFNS to date.





RE/MAX Park Place Inc. generously donated a portion of sales to support Cape Bretoners who must travel to the IWK for care. In addition to their work as realtors, the group hosts fundraisers throughout the year, demonstrating their commitment to both health care and community. This year, their efforts resulted in a donation of **\$14,474.81**, helping to cover costs such as gas, accommodations, and transportation for families facing the 5+ hour trip for treatment. Since 2007, the group has contributed \$189,514.89 to this important cause.

Bras d'Or Elementary hosted their annual fundraiser in support of the **Tom McNeil Cancer Patient Care Fund**, celebrating a record year with a fundraising total of **\$6,081.00!** These funds will support up to 100 Cape Breton cancer patients who rely on this fund each month. Students and staff of the Elementary have now raised \$40,081.85 for our Foundation over the past 10 years.



Unblock the Clot, hosted by Janelle Tierney, is a run in support of thrombosis awareness. Adding an auction to this year's efforts, Janelle, the committee, and participants raised **\$17,959.00 for the Vital Patient-Care Fund**. This fund supports more than 30 patients a month in units throughout every floor of the CBRH. Over the past two years, this event has raised \$26,923.00.

Shoppers Foundation for Women's Health dedicated **\$80,000** to our Foundation through their Community Grants Program, with a goal of supporting women's health. This generous grant provided financial support to the **Family Newborn TLC Fund**, caring for our littlest patients and their families; **Forget Me Not Packages**, which offer comfort and care items to families experiencing pregnancy loss; and, **The Baby Box Program**, which supplies newborn necessities to families in need. To date, SFWH has provided \$113,792.00 in support of our Foundation.

ADVANCING *care*

INVESTING IN VITAL EQUIPMENT, HERE AT *home*

Thanks to the unwavering generosity of our donors, 2025 saw one of our largest investments in vital equipment for our hospital and health care in Cape Breton. Together, we invested **\$972,253.00** to **purchase 22 new pieces of technology** for our hospital. Because you care, our Island's health care experts have access to more of the tools they need to provide the best possible care, right here, at home.

Here are some examples of what your support has helped to purchase:

PORTABLE ULTRASOUND MACHINES **\$201,210.00**

Thanks to those who supported Radio Day 2024, **four Portable Ultrasound Machines** were purchased in 2025 to support the **Emergency Department, Coronary Care Unit, and Intensive Care Unit**. From trauma patients arriving to the emergency room, intensive care patients needing life-saving medications, to cardiac patients presenting with unidentified heart complications, and more, these machines allow health care experts to make faster decisions and to provide more precise treatments.



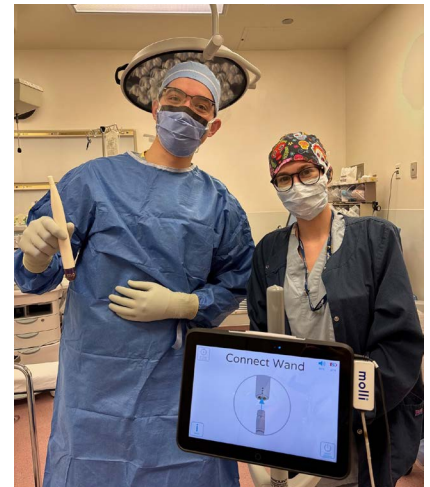
PAIN PUMPS **\$12,816.00**

Thanks to donors who support our **Palliative Care fund**, **two pain pumps** were purchased to provide comfort to those at end of life or needing symptom relief. These pumps stay with the patient, allowing for steady, consistent medication doses under the skin. Because these pumps allow patients to give themselves a 'breakthrough' dose of medication when needed, it offers them the choice to be at home for end of life with more comfort.



MOLLI INTRODUCER \$240,900.00

The MOLLI Introducer offers a wire-free method to mark lesions for **breast cancer surgery**, enabling care teams to localize affected tissue ahead of time. Previously, patients had to come in early for their breast surgery to have a needle placed, followed by laying in a stretcher (sometimes for hours) with a protective cup over the needle so as not to dislodge it while awaiting surgery. Because of donors who supported the **Cancer Care Here at Home campaign**, this uncomfortable experience is no longer necessary.



VEIN FINDER \$29,393.00

Teal to Heal donors have helped to purchase a vein finder for the **Cape Breton Cancer Centre**. The Centre supports up to 30 patients daily, most of which require an IV. The Vein Finder increases the chances of successful vein access on the first attempt, significantly reducing patient discomfort and the need for multiple insertions.



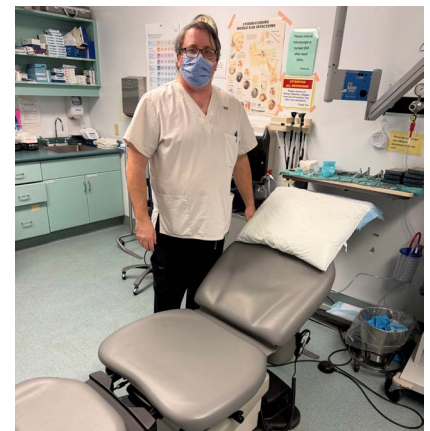
NICU EQUIPMENT \$250,899.00

Several pieces of vital equipment have been purchased for the **Neonatal Intensive Care Unit** at the CBRH. These items include a **laryngoscope** with video attachment to help guide intubation in babies requiring resuscitation; a new **incubator** to replace those that are now at end-of-life in the unit and support infants needing critical care; **glider chairs** to improve comfort for breastfeeding; **breast pumps** to express milk to infants; mobile phototherapy systems that allow babies with jaundice to receive treatment at home; and more.



EXAM CHAIR \$19,812.00

An exam chair for **Ear, Nose, Throat (ENT)** patients was purchased for **Ambulatory Care**, to provide comfortable and adjustable seating for examinations and procedures. The chair, which offers enhanced accessibility and positioning capabilities, ensures optimal patient comfort and ease for health care experts as they work to provide thorough examinations.
